# Rules of Engagement

# FW in Normal Type = Friendship (Group) Walk TW in Bold Type = Traditional Walk

DB = Don's Bike Events

- 1. An email message will be sent for all events on this schedule to anyone interested. The message will contain location, time, directions, and trail description. If you are not receiving the weekly email Walk Alerts, send Don Ratliff an email request at dratliff1515@gmail.com
- 2. Traditional Walks (TW) have a start time window usually between 8:00 AM and 12:00 Noon. The *COMPASS* has information on these walks, including point of contact.
- 3. Friendship (group) Walks (FW) will start at 9:30 AM unless announced otherwise.
- 4. Bike rides will start with signup at 9:15 and ride at 9:30 except during the hot months of June, July and August (we will see about Sept) when they are scheduled at signup at 8:15 and ride at 8:30. Don and Marillyn Ratliff may not be available for all the group bikes scheduled.
- 5. Bike outings will **not** take place in rain, high wind or when the route is hazardous. In those cases, bikers will be asked to do the walk if available. All bike event participants must wear a helmet.
- 6. Staffing of Friendship Walk events is minimal and provided by other walkers to help expedite registration and get the walk started promptly at about the time indicated. We try to be available a half-hour before the start times but are occasionally tardy. If you get there before help arrives, go ahead and start registration or just have patience.

This schedule is not sponsored by any club or association; it is the sole effort of Don Ratliff, and subject to change, although reluctantly. Check the Placer Pacers website www.placerpacers.org for the latest schedule.
